My office cannot compel any further action as the agreement was legally terminated and the University of Kentucky owns and possesses the organ.

I was not disputing the University of Kentucky's right to Terminate the Project Agreement!

BTW: Your response in the above referenced email information has little to do with the Filing of the Formal Compliant with the Citizen's Advocate. This is just an initial step!

I suggest you go back and reread the written formal complaint, especially the manner in which General Services Commissioner Reed (now Acting Chief of Staff for Mayor Gray) has;

1. Conducted multiple meetings concerning KMW, which intentionally excluded KMW from participation within those meetings, which provided hearsay information at best.
2. The Complaint also included 18 Request for Information, which Former Commissioner Reed did not offer nor responded to these 18-RFI. If this Complaint and Civil Action goes to Court, I can assure you and the LFUCG these will be included in a list discovery interrogatories.
3. The nearly 1,000 Donors to KMW's donated to this project because the 3/18 Wurlitzer organ was going back to its rightful Kentucky Theatre Home, KMW participated and executed this agreement as sole-fundraising authority and marketed this Project Agreement with this commitment, of which the LFUCG and UK ineptly derailed the project, and Commissioner Reed (LFUCG) has been complicit by manipulating UK thru a failed RFP process and termination of KMW's hope to return the Wurlitzer organ to it's rightful home in the Kentucky Theatre, which has now, potentially placed KMW in harms way by this action!

4. On March 15, 2016 KMW will issue a Comprehensive Media Release concerning events, and failure of the LFUCG to provide KMW with due process to participate in these meetings with disparate groups referenced in the November 2, 2015 Email to Katherine Adams.

5. Over the past three weeks, I have made at least two calls to Maureen Watson to set a meeting with Mayor Gray to discuss in a friendly manner these issues. During Ms. Watson's call back to me, I was told to contact the LFUCG Law Department? A second call has been initiated without action?

I will be meeting with KMW's attorney this week to discuss these issues and KMW's options to Protect our Donors and our integrity.
